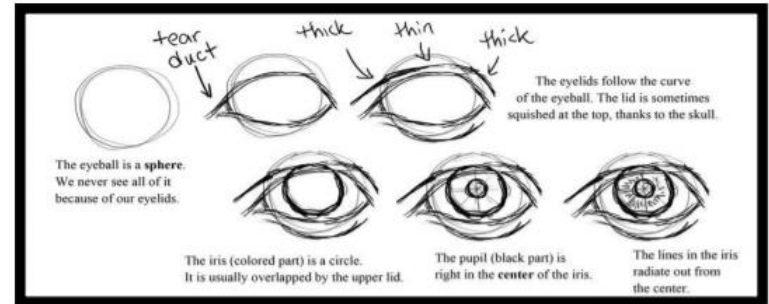


Deliberate Practice

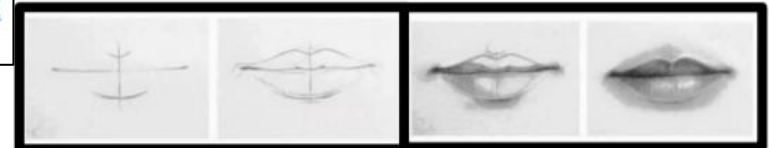
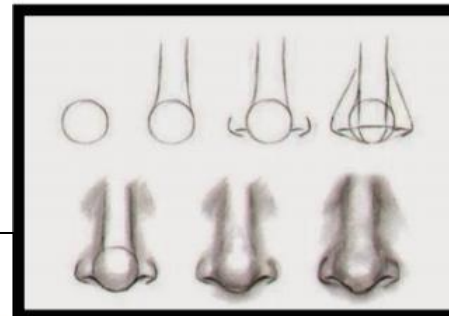

Deliberate Practice- Drawing

- Practice drawing features of the face with **accuracy** Add **tone** through **blending**.
1. Draw an eye
 2. Draw a nose
 3. Draw lips

one eye length in between eyes

crown of head to eyes equals half of head's length

nose is about halfway between eyes and chin

mouth is halfway between nose and chin

ears extend from brow to nose

Graffiti Art



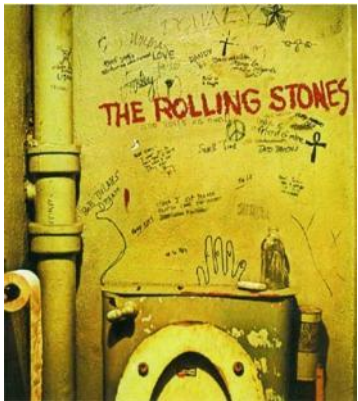
Graffiti is a form of **visual communication** involving writing or drawing on a wall or other surface, often without permission and within public view. Graffiti ranges from simple written words to elaborate wall paintings, and has existed since ancient times, with examples dating back to ancient Egypt, ancient Greece, and the Roman Empire.

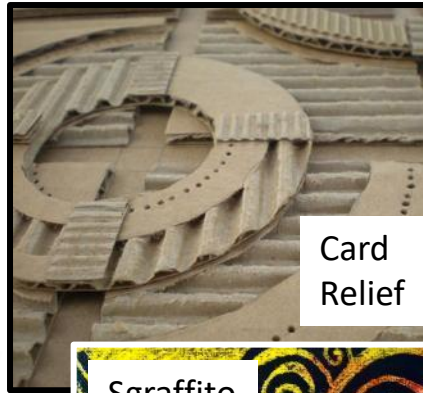
